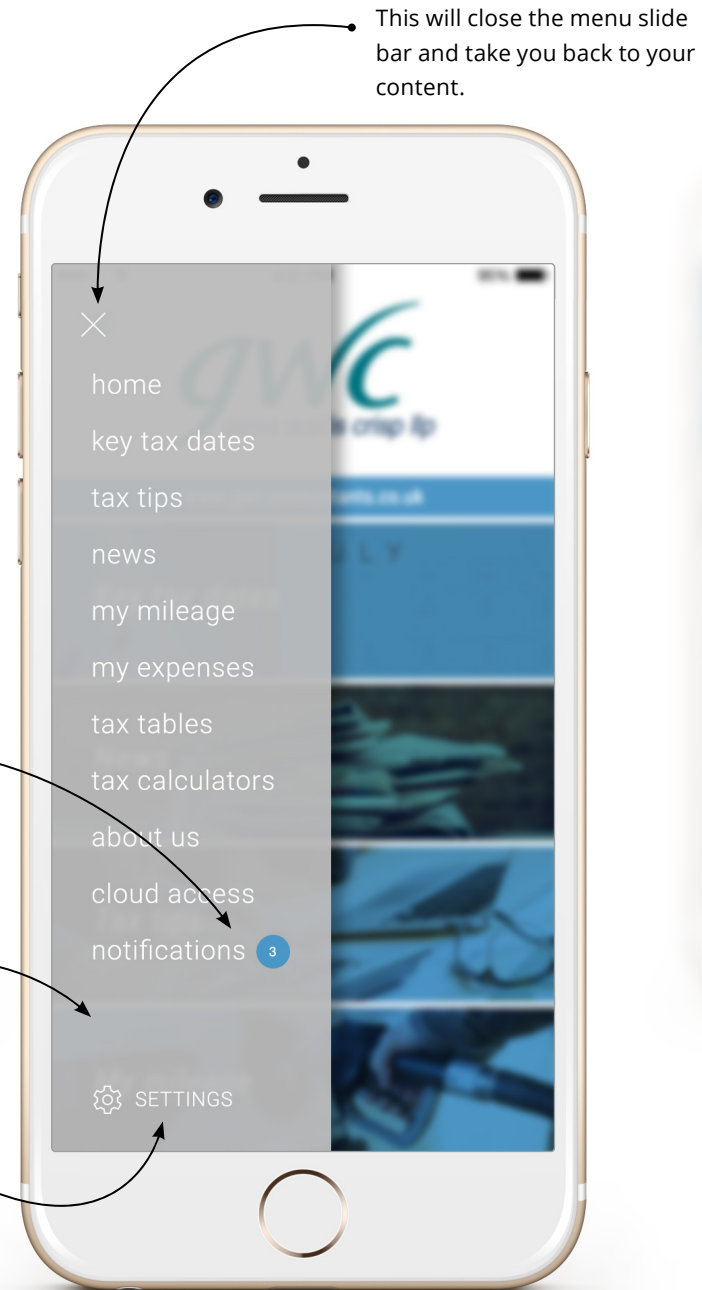
Upon pressing the hamburger menu button from the home screen, the menu slides out from the left.
